

Jurisprudence Examination

As of January 20, 2010 PAM has made its Jurisprudence Examination mandatory for all applicants. The examination is an open book multiple choice format exam designed to assess an applicant's knowledge of local jurisprudence matters (e.g., relevant laws and regulations affecting those who practice Psychology). Arrangements to write the Jurisprudence Exam are made through the Chair of the Registration Committee who will forward to the applicant a list of relevant laws, Acts, and By-Laws for review. The applicant may bring this information to the exam with her/him.
