

Jurisprudence Examination

PAM will begin administering a Jurisprudence Examination to all applicants in April, 2008.

This follows a lengthy period of test item development. This will be a pilot testing phase. All new applications received on or after April 1, 2008 will require that the applicant take the Jurisprudence Examination prior to the Oral Examination or Interview. This applies to all categories of registration, including psychological candidates, psychological associates and reciprocal or mutual recognition applicants. Until further notice, those applicants or candidates already in the stream prior to April 1 will be given the option of taking the examination. During this pilot phase, applicants will be provided with feedback on their performance, but their results/scores will not count towards registration. The examination is multiple choice and focuses on local (Manitoba) laws and regulations relevant to the practice of psychology.

Candidates will be provided with a reading list in advance of the examination, and the examination will be "open book". Further details will be provided as they become available.
