

## **Information on applying for the Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology (EPPP) for Registration as a Psychologist or Psychological Associate in Manitoba**

This page will outline application information for individuals applying for registration in Manitoba. All applicants for registration as a Psychologist or Psychological Associate in Manitoba must write the *Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology (EPPP)* and obtain a passing score equivalent to 70%. Scores are now scaled so that a scaled score of 500 is equivalent to 70%.

You can apply to take the EPPP once you are registered with PAM as a Psychologist Candidate or Psychological Associate Candidate. You cannot take the EPPP until your membership application has been completed and approved by Council. If you are applying for registration in another jurisdiction, you should contact that jurisdiction for information on taking the EPPP.

Once you are ready to take the EPPP, you should notify the Registrar who will then direct you to the appropriate ASPPB link to register for the exam. ASPPB maintains complete responsibility for registering applicants to write the EPPP. Once you register for the EPPP (and pay the fee in place at the time), the Registrar will verify your candidacy to write and you will then receive an e-mail giving you permission to take the exam. From that date you will have 60 days to write the exam. If you do not write within that 60 day window, you will have to re-register for the exam, and pay again. ASPPB is responsible for setting the fee for the exam and at this time, PAM does not charge anything for verifying your candidacy to write.
