**Information on the Oral Examination and the Oral Interview  
for Registration as a Psychologist in Manitoba**  
(2005-1)

All applicants for registration as a psychologist in Manitoba must pass an oral examination. The oral examination is the last requirement to be completed, and cannot be administered until **all other requirements have been met**, and the applicant has been approved by PAM council to proceed to an oral examination.

Oral exams are not required of Psychological Associates. They may not be required for applicants already registered in another jurisdiction. Individuals applying from other Canadian provinces or territories under the terms of the Mutual Recognition Agreement will be subject to an Oral Interview, not an examination. The Oral Interview will review your intended areas of practice in Manitoba, and your knowledge of local regulations, legislation, law, etc. (local jurisprudence).

The cost of the oral examination or interview, effective January 1, 2004, is \$300.00. This fee is utilized to reimburse examiners for their time.

When you are ready to take the oral examination or interview, you should complete the "Application for Oral Examination or Oral Interview", and submit it to PAM, along with your examination fee. The Application is available on the website at [www.cpmb.ca](http://www.cpmb.ca) under "Examinations". You should submit an application for oral only when all education and supervision requirements for registration as a psychologist have been completed, including the year of post-doctoral supervision. If, at the time of application for membership, you have already completed all of these requirements, you should submit your oral application and fee with your membership application.
