## Examination for Professional Practice in Psychology (EPPP Part 1-Knowledge and Part 2-Skills)

Passing of the EPPP Part 1-Knowledge and Part 2-Skills is required to obtain a certificate of registration authorizing autonomous practice in Manitoba.

- The EPPP Part 1-Knowledge assesses foundational knowledge related to the practice of psychology.
- The EPPP Part 2-Skills is a skills-based assessment that includes questions about applied, real
  world situations that psychologists face in practice and can only be taken after the EPPP (Part 1Knowledge) has been taken and passed. The passing score of the EPPP (Part 2-Skills) is 500. If
  a candidate comes close to a pass (490-499) then they are advised to contact the office to
  discuss potential options.
