

Instructions for Internationally Trained Applicants

Beginning July 15, 2020, all internationally trained applicants (those applicants trained outside of Canada or the United States) are required to apply for registration through the ACPRO (Association of Canadian Psychology Regulatory Organizations) online portal. By using this online application portal, your demographics, educational history, supervised practice experience, and prior work experience will be verified and gathered together for review by the regulatory body in your intended province of practice. The purpose of the portal is to offer a fair, transparent, and consistent mechanism for internationally trained applicants to apply for registration. Please note that in Manitoba, decisions on the acceptability of any applicant's education, training, and supervised experience, for registration with PAM are made by the PAM Registration and Membership committee and Executive Council. This process involves a review of documentation submitted by the applicant through this online portal.
