NOTICE OF HEARING

A panel of the Inquiry Committee of the Psychological Association of Manitoba (the "Panel") will be convening at 360 Main Street, 30th Floor, Winnipeg, Manitoba (the offices of MLT Aikins LLP) on January 13, 2025 at 1:00 p.m. to convene and conduct a hearing into charges issued on June 4, 2024 and October 16, 2024 against Dr. X, a registrant of the Psychological Association of Manitoba in accordance with Regulation 31/2006 being Psychological Association of Manitoba By-law No. 1, passed pursuant to *The Psychologists Registration Act* (By-law No. 1").

The hearing is expected to continue until on or about January 31, 2025, however this is subject to change at the direction of the Panel. The hours of the hearing on days subsequent to January 13, 2025 will be as directed by the Panel.

All hearings are open to the public unless the Panel orders that all or part of the hearing be held in private. The purpose of the Inquiry is to ensure that an impartial hearing is given to the person who has been charged and that the public interest has been served.

A hearing, or any part of it, may be held in private pursuant to subsection 36(2) of By-law No. 1. The decision to close a portion or all of the hearing can be made at the last minute, and all public attendees will be asked to leave the hearing room or disconnect from the hearing if it is being held virtually.

No recordings of the proceedings are permitted (audio, video, or photographs) by any attendees. If the hearing is being held virtually, no recordings or screenshots are permitted.

Pursuant to subsection 36(1) of By-law No. 1, the reporting of anything which may identify a registrant charged (including the name, name of clinic or partnership, location of

practice, etc.) is prohibited unless or until the Panel makes a finding against the registrant. If ordered by the Panel, a complainant or any witness may only be identified by initials.
