Jennifer Laforce Bio

Jennifer C. Laforce, PhD, C. Psych, is a registered psychologist in private practice in Winnipeg, Manitoba. She previously served on the Executive Council for the Psychological Association of Manitoba (2011-2019) and on the board of the Manitoba Psychological Society Manitoba (2006-2011). From 2004-2013 she was an Assistant Professor in the Department of Clinical Health Psychology at the University of Manitoba and worked at the Winnipeg Operational Stress Injury Clinic, serving as Clinical Director from 2009-2013. Dr. Laforce received her doctorate degree in Clinical Psychology from Queen's University at Kingston, Ontario and completed her internship at SUNY Upstate in Syracuse, NY. She is the current President-Elect on the Board of Directors for Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards (ASPPB), after serving as Member-at-Large, Board of Directors, ASPPB, 2022-2024.

Who is eligible for a nomination to council?

A nominee for council must be a psychologist (C.Psych member)

Who can nominate a psychologist for PAM Council?

A Psychologist or Psychological Associate (Independent Practice)

Nomination Deadline & Instructions:

- The enclosed fillable nomination form must be submitted to the registrar by mail or email no later than **April 24, 2025**.
- Each nominee must be nominated by three Psychologists and/or Psychological Associates (Independent Practitioner) in good standing using the same form
- The term for each position to be filled is two years

Election by Acclamation: If the Registrar receives seven nominations for the seven council positions, nominees are elected by acclamation and balloting is not required at the AGM. If balloting is required it will be conducted by a polling process at the virtual AGM.

Council and Time Commitments:

Council meets every third Thursday of the month (in summer meetings if required) Meetings are typically 3 hours long over Zoom Conference or in-person every second month approximately (dinner provided).

President, Vice-President, Treasurer positions and Committee Chairs are determined by the elected Council and are not an obligation for new members.
